## B/SR-4 **Delegation to the Superintendent**

The Board will instruct the superintendent through written policies that prescribe the district results to be achieved and describe situations and actions to be avoided, and will allow the superintendent to use any reasonable interpretation of those policies.

Accordingly:

- 1. The Board will develop policies instructing the superintendent to achieve defined results for identified recipients at a specified cost. These policies will be developed systematically from the broadest, most general level to more defined levels, and will be called Results policies.
- 2. The Board will develop policies that limit the latitude the superintendent may exercise in choosing the district's means. These policies will be developed systematically from the broadest, most general level to more defined levels, and they will be called *Executive* Limitations policies.
- 3. As long as the superintendent uses any reasonable interpretation of the Board's *Results* and *Executive Limitations* policies, the superintendent is authorized to establish all further administrative policies, make all decisions, take all actions, establish all practices and develop all activities the superintendent deems appropriate to achieve the Board's Results policies.
- 4. The Board may change its *Results* and *Executive Limitations* policies at any time, thereby shifting the boundary between Board and superintendent domains. By doing so, the Board changes the latitude of choice given to the superintendent. However, as long as any Board-specified delegation of authority is in place, the Board will respect and support any reasonable interpretation of its policies, even though superintendent choices may not be the choices the Board or its members may have made.
