Clinical Mental Health Counselor Vacancy

Chetek Weyerhaeuser Area School District is seeking a candidate for full-time clinical mental health counselor working with children and adolescents in a school setting. Starting annual salary will vary slightly based on qualifications of the applicant (\$45,000 to \$49,000 plus benefits). This is a continuing position and will follow the school staff calendar (the contract will be 192 days annually with an extended contract as needed).

Position Description

The Chetek Weyerhaeuser Area School District therapist will provide on-site therapeutic services to our students in pre-kindergarten through 12th grade. This will include providing group and individual therapy sessions for students, developing and implementing therapy treatment plans, participation in district child study and problem solving team meetings as appropriate; and providing professional development for staff as needed.

Knowledge, Skills and Qualifications

- Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) or Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT)
- Full-Licensure preferred but willing to consider a LPC-IT or MFT-IT
- Specific training and experience in working with children, adolescents, and their families
- Training in cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT)
- Training in play based therapy
- Connects and communicate well with children and adolescents
- Comfortable working with children and adolescents with emotional and behavioral difficulties
- Ability and willingness to work as part of a team
- Outstanding written and verbal communication skills

About the District

The Chetek-Weyerhaeuser Area School District is located in Chetek, Wisconsin. Chetek is a small resort community in west central Wisconsin. The chain of six lakes makes Chetek a popular vacation spot for those interested in water recreation activities. All together these lakes cover some 3,800 surface acres with over 120 miles of shoreline, which is dotted with islands and quiet bays. Tourism has been a major industry in Chetek for more than five generations.

The Chetek-Weyerhaeuser Area School District provides educational services to approximately 1000 students district wide. The percentage of students qualifying for free and reduced lunch in the district has remained consistently high. In the 2015-16 school year 44.75% of our district population qualified for free and reduced lunch. The former Chetek Area Schools consolidated with the former Weyerhaeuser School District in July of 2010.

Chetek-Weyerhaeuser is a progressive school district with a school motto of “we take care of each other”. Unfortunate recent events have made it evident that this motto is alive and well in our school and community. Chetek-Weyerhaeuser is a blend of two communities with a common goal: to prepare students for success after they walk our halls. Students have access to a wealth of opportunities and are encouraged to challenge themselves by being involved in academic as well as co-curricular opportunities. The district employs two full-time school counselors and two part-time school psychologists as well as a multitude of teaching specialists.
