New Social Worker Program Begins at CW

CWASD is excited to welcome Nicholle Hayton as the new social worker with Chetek-Weyerhaeuser School District! She is looking forward to bringing this service to the district and community, and being a part of a wonderful team!

Hayton is a Rice Lake native, born and raised, and graduated in 2013. She attended one year at the University Wisconsin-Barron County to complete general education credits before uprooting herself and moving to Illinois with her high school sweetheart to follow his hockey career to the collegiate level. While in Illinois, she attended Brescia University's online program to major in Social Work while working full time in the social services field. After completing her bachelor's degree, she pursued her Masters of Social Work through Aurora University in Aurora, Illinois, while continuing to work full-time in the social services field.

Hayton is currently licensed as an Advanced Practice Social Worker through the State of Wisconsin and has completed her required hours to be eligible to test for her Licensed Clinical Social Work license. With this, she is also able to practice therapy.

Hayton has a wide range of knowledge in many areas of social work and hopes to continue to grow and share her knowledge with CW families and staff!

So what does this mean for the district? Chetek-Weyerhaeuser is dedicated to providing comprehensive support that addresses many of the out-of-school needs that can hinder students' learning abilities. CW's School Social Work Program is designed to help tackle those barriers. By connecting schools, families and our community, school officials are better able to support students as a whole.

When students are struggling, a school social worker can support parents in facilitating their child's adjustment to school. Examples may include things such as: helping students transition back into school after extended absences due to illness or other factors, working with families during stressful times such as divorce or death, or connecting families with area resources. The goal is to help families resolve difficult life situations.

Using a wraparound model, which involves linking professionals and key people in the students' lives, our school social worker is able to help facilitate more coordinated services for students and families. The school social worker is then also able to provide school staff with essential information to help them better understand factors that may affect student performance and behavior.

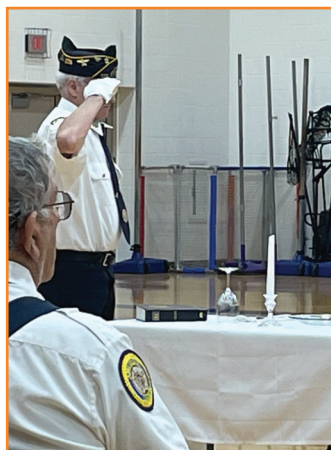


CWHS/MS Students Honor Veterans with Ceremony
