CWHS Boys Track Wins D3 WIAA State Title!

Congratulations to the D3 WIAA State Boys Track and Field State Champions!! That's right! Our CWHS boys' track team won the state championship in LaCrosse on the weekend of June 4! With 44 points they earned the title over Athens and Durand. The 4x200 meter relay team took first place, too, en route to the title!

The last State Title was in 1985. There was a celebratory parade on Wednesday, June 8 through downtown Chetek.

At the state girls meet, we had runners in the 4x400 relay team - Anastasia Mujwid, Zoe Nelson, Kaylee Haas, Taya Whittenberger and alternate Mariah Bilodeau.

The boys' team took medals in several events en route to the state title: Lawson Davis - 110 hurdles (4th), triple jump (8th), and high jump (4th); Ashton and Carter Kummet - 200m dash (2nd and 3rd, respectively); 4x100 and 4x200 relay teams of Carter Kummet, Tristan Wendt, Tyler Monnier and Ashton Kummet (3rd and 1st places, respectively); and Tyler Monnier – 100M dash (6th).
