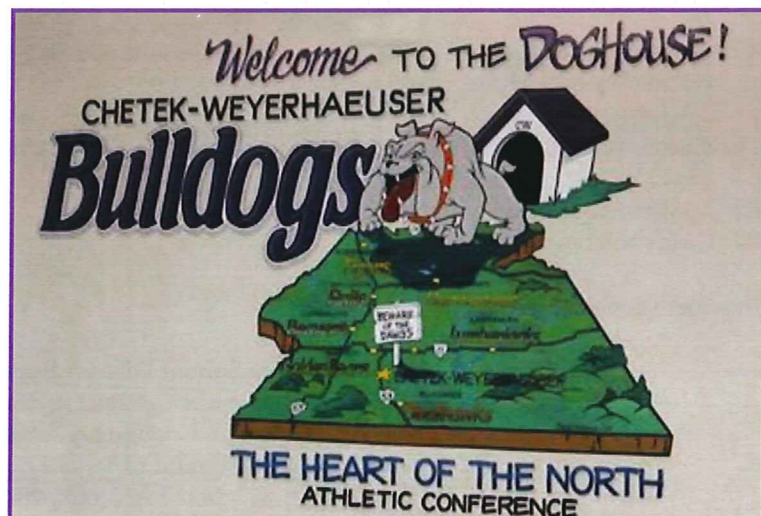
The following leadership skills are also important to the students, staff, board, and community:
