Information

A.Federal Health Insurance Changes for 2025: We received notice that the IRS increased the minimum deductible required for embedded family deductible HDHP's. Effective January 1, 2025 the minimum family-embedded deductible will increase from \$3,200 to \$3,300 for the 2025 calendar year. HDHP Increase Information (see school website for link) In 2024, the deductible increased from \$3,000 to \$3,200 for embedded status.

Our district has a calendar year (January 1 - December 31) deductible, but our Open Enrollment date isn't until later (June 1-15). Our broker recommends increasing the health insurance deductible on January 1, 2025, instead of waiting until July 1, 2025. If we wait until July 1 to make this change, members who have

met their deductible from January 1, 2025 to June 30, 2025 would have to meet additional deductible starting on July 1, 2025. Staff thinking they met the deductible and then finding out they need to meet an additional deductible after July 1, 2025, can be confusing and frustrating. We prefer to eliminate this hurdle before it occurs.

We have some options to choose from:

- 1.Increase family embedded deductible from \$3,200 to \$3,300 effective January 1, 2025.
- 2.Do not increase the deductible until July 1, 2025.
- 3.Do nothing and allow the embedded plan to be non-embedded.
- 4. Increase the deductible to \$3,500, which may keep us ahead of any projected changes for next year.
- 5.Increase family deductible from \$3,200 to \$3,300 effective January 1, 2025, AND the District contributes an additional \$100 to HSA's for all staff with family health plans on January 10, 2025. (Costing approximately \$7200.00)

NOTE: **Embedded deductible** is a health insurance plan feature that gives each family member their own deductible. This means that if one family member meets their individual deductible before the family deductible is met, the insurance company will start paying for that member's covered expenses.

We will have a formal recommendation for the BOE at the December meeting.

Motion by Lentz, seconded by Olson to approve the increase of family embedded deductible from \$3,200 to \$3,300 effective January 1, 2025. Motion carried. Hamilton abstained.

Motion by Lentz, seconded by Olson to approve the district contributing an additional \$100 to HSAs for single staff and \$200 for family effective January 10, 2025. Motion carried. Hamilton abstained.
