



B. Budget Assumptions 2017-18

- 1. Fiscal Year 2017-18 student enrollment projection based on the September membership counts. This Shows an increase of 24 students.
- 2. General Education Revenue will be projected subject to legislative action. Tammy will do a projection on \$0 increase per student with maximum revenue per student \$11,517.00. Tammy will also do a projection based on \$200 increase per student with maximum revenue per student \$11,717.00.
- 3. Aid for special education is calculated using current year fiscal data. It is projected at a 0 to a -2% Increase/decrease. Per pupil categorial aid is projected at \$250.00 per student.
- 4. Include a 2017-18 budget allocation of \$10,000.00 for Advanced Learner Programming.

Motion by Haselhuhn, seconded by Goulette to approve the four above named budget assumptions. Motion carried.
