EL-9 Asset Protection

The superintendent shall not allow assets to be unprotected, inadequately maintained, inappropriately used or unnecessarily risked.

Accordingly, the superintendent may not:

- 1. Fail to obtain insurance coverage against burglary and casualty losses to 100% of replacement value and against liability losses to Board members, staff and the district itself in an amount that is reasonable for school districts of like size.
- 2. Allow un-bonded personnel access to funds in excess of amounts defined by district insurance policies.
- 3. Fail to take reasonable steps to ensure that the facilities and equipment are not subject to improper wear and tear or insufficient maintenance.
- 4. Knowingly or recklessly expose the district, its Board or staff to legal liability.
- 5. Make any purchase:
 - a. without exercising reasonable precaution against conflict of interest.
 - b. without having obtained comparative prices based on items of similar quality.
 - c. without considering a balance between long-term quality and initial cost.
- 6. Fail to use a competitive bidding process for capital improvements in excess of \$10,000 with no splitting of orders to avoid the limit.
- 7. Fail to protect intellectual property, information and files from loss or significant damage.
- 8. Fail to preserve and dispose of all records related to affairs or business of the district in accordance with state and federal law.
- 9. Receive, process or disburse funds under controls that are insufficient under generally accepted accounting procedures.
- 10. Invest funds in securities that are not authorized by state law.
- 11. Acquire, encumber, or dispose of real property.
- 12. Knowingly or recklessly endanger the district's public image or credibility, thereby jeopardizing its ability to accomplish its mission.
