EL-13 INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS SELECTION

The superintendent shall not fail to select textbooks and instructional materials that advance the achievement of the Board's *Results* policies.

Accordingly, the superintendent may not:

1. Fail to ensure appropriate input from the following groups as instructional materials are reviewed and selected: students, parents, teachers, administrators and other staff members involved in developing the education program.
2. Fail to select text and materials that contribute toward continuity, integration and articulation of the curriculum by course and program.
3. Fail to consider the diverse needs of all learners when selecting instructional materials.
4. Fail to provide a procedure for the scheduled evaluation of instructional materials and a procedure for reviewing such materials upon formal request by a parent or other stakeholder.
5. Fail to develop and implement appropriate policies governing access to and utilization of electronically distributed information and material.
6. Fail to consider technological ease of assessment when selecting instructional materials.
