EL-13 INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS SELECTION

The superintendent shall not fail to select textbooks and instructional materials that advance the achievement of the Board's *Results* policies.

Accordingly, the superintendent may not:

- 1. Fail to ensure appropriate input from the following groups as instructional materials are reviewed and selected: students, parents, teachers, administrators and other staff members involved in developing the education program.
- 2. Fail to select text and materials that contribute toward continuity, integration and articulation of the curriculum by course and program.
- 3. Fail to consider the diverse needs of all learners when selecting instructional materials.
- 4. Fail to provide a procedure for the scheduled evaluation of instructional materials and a procedure for reviewing such materials upon formal request by a parent or other stakeholder.
- 5. Fail to develop and implement appropriate policies governing access to and utilization of electronically distributed information and material.
- 6. Fail to consider technological ease of assessment when selecting instructional materials.
