Purpose

The District was established in law by the legislature as prescribed by the constitution. The statute enumerates the duties and powers of school boards and asserts "public education is a fundamental responsibility of the state". The overall educational goals specifically outlined are: academic skills and knowledge; vocational skills; citizenship; personal development; and health and safety. The law goes on to state "the development of academic skills and knowledge is the most important goal for schools."

Therefore, with these requirements at the forefront, the purpose of the Chetek-Weyerhaeuser Area School is to provide public education in accordance with its statutory duties and consistent with the expectations of the public it serves. This results in students that are productive workers, fair-minded citizens and life-long learners.
